

SECOND MEETING OF HARYANA KISAN AYOOG (08 November, 2010)

PROCEEDINGS

The Second Meeting of *Haryana Kisan Ayog* was held on 8th November, 2010 at 2.30 p.m. in the office of the Chairman, Haryana Kisan Ayog, CCSHAU campus, Hisar under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.S. Paroda. The following were present:-

At the outset, the Member-Secretary welcomed the Chairman and members of the commission. He gave an update on the work done so far by the commission. He informed the commission that efforts have been made for the establishment of the commission. Budget for the commission has been provided through the Dy. Director, Agri., Hisar. This is a temporary arrangement and from the next financial year budget will be directly provided to the commission. The Administrative Officer has joined on deputation from the state government. To cope up with the office work some staff has been engaged through a service provider on the terms and conditions approved by the university for hiring such services. Proposals for purchase of vehicles and reappropriation of budget as per our requirement have been submitted to the Government. These are under process.

Dr. Paroda, in his opening remarks, thanked the F.C. Agri. And V.C. CCS HAU for their support in the establishment of the office the Commission. He further informed the commission about his discussions with senior functionaries of ICAR as well as CIMMYT. The commission has already received a letter from D.G. ICAR about support from ICAR for the state. A meeting has been fixed with the group on conservation agriculture from CIMMYT and scientists of CCS HAU at Hisar on 8.11.10 with all members of the commission. He further informed the commission about the progress made in formation of the working groups, especially the group being constituted to prepare the draft policy on agriculture for Haryana He also brought out that establishing an office at Gurgaon and purchase of vehicles is yet to materialise and is taking rather too long a time which is hampering the working of the commission. He emphasised the need to expedite action on these.

The commission then discussed in details each of the listed agenda and took the following decisions:

Item No.-1: Confirmation of the proceedings of the 1st meeting of the Haryana Kisan Ayog held on 10.09.2010.

The proceedings of the first meeting were confirmed.

Item No.-2: Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the first meeting of the Haryana Kisan Ayog.

The commission noted the actions taken.

Item No.-3: Renovation of office space.

Approved as proposed.

Item No. 4 : Recruitment of staff

Approved as proposed. Further, the commission authorised the Member Secretary to take any appropriate step and follow any reasonable procedure for recruitment of staff with the approval of the Chairman.
