The project report has suggested the Block Specific Recommendations for sustainable land use for agricultural development in Haryana. The recommendations made by the project may be implemented by the Agriculture and Horticulture Department for overall development of agriculture in the State.

Interface with Farmers, Planners and Scientists

To understand the farmers' problems, requirements and their capacity to change, the Haryana Kisan & Agricultural Costs and Prices Commission frequently organized farmer interaction meetings/workshops/seminars, etc. in which planners, scientists and officers from the line department are invited to interact and share views. The salient recommendations are sent to government for consideration in their policies for the welfare of farmers and the society.



Awareness Campaign on "Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna" and Crop Residue Management

Awareness campaign on "Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna" (PMFBY) in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare and "Krishi Udyami Krishak Vikas Chamber" (KUKVC) has been organized in each districts of the state. The objective has been to de-risk the farmers from losses on account of natural calamities and stabilize their income. Interactions with farmers were also held for crop residue management and to have feedback for the success of the Government policies.



Bhavantar Bharpayee Yojna

The Government of Haryana is first to launch an innovative scheme named as Bhavantar Bharpai Yojna on the recommendation of the committee under the chairmanship of Chairman, HKACPC to compensate the basic price of vegetables namely, Potato, Onion, Tomato and Cauliflower.



Branding of Specific Produce of Haryana State

Haryana is known for its various area specific agricultural commodities. In order to facilitate and encourage the farmers for marketing with value addition and specific produce such as Aterna Baby Corn, Mannauli Sweet Corn, Taraori Rice, Jhajjar kheri Guava, Dabwali Kinnow, etc. The Commission is taking up to register the Geographical Indications and Trade Mark for specific produce of Haryana. This step is aim to popularize the produce of the State and also enhance the farmers' income.

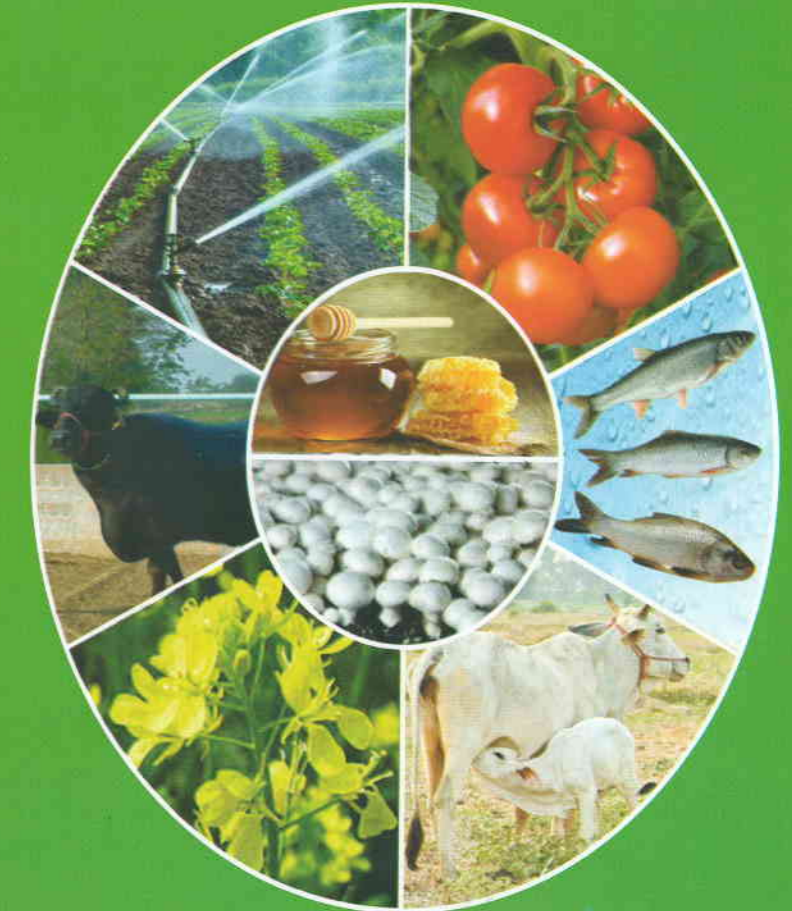

As a progressive step to serve the cause of farmers of the State, Government of Haryana decided to establish a Haryana Farmers' Commission on 15 July, 2010. It is commonly known as "Haryana Kisan & Agricultural Costs and Prices Commission" and has its Headquarter at Anaj Mandi, Sector-20, Panchkula. The commission is chaired by Dr. Ramesh Kumar Yadava. Mrs. Navraj Sandhu, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Department, Dr. K. P. Singh, VC, CCSHAU, Hisar. Dr. Shyam Bhaskar and Dr. Rajender Singh Balyan are its members. Presently Dr. R. S. Balyan has been given the charge of Member Secretary.

Major Objectives

- To review the current status of Haryana agriculture, its performance, strength and weaknesses.
- To assess the conditions of different categories of farmers in various agro-climatic sub-regions and work out a comprehensive strategy for achieving sustainable and equitable agricultural development of the State.
- To analyze the factors responsible for the decline in farm income and suggest measures to enhance income of the farmers.
- To propose methods of enhancing the productivity, profitability, stability and sustainability of the major farming systems of the State.
- To suggest a viable and compatible crop (including horticulture) – livestock – fish integrated system and synergy between agriculture and allied sectors.
- To examine the current input use efficiency and functioning of the delivery systems for seeds, pesticides and credit and to suggest improvements therein.
- To review the current status of water use in agriculture, and suggest the measures to reform its efficiency.
